



## 2022 Annual General Meeting Vice-President Report

1. I started year 2021 as OVO Acting President still in charge of one Walk Box: PT # 277, Tribute to Canadian Armed Forces and I guided the Remembrance Day Walk on Thursday, November 11, 2021. I also contributed to our August 21, 2021 walk in Carson Grove/Cardinal Heights area by selecting, walking and drafting the instructions of the 5 km walk.
2. I was still the Chair of the Joint Committee of the OVO and the Nomads for the 2021 More Days Walk and Bike Event, which was once again cancelled due to COVID-19.
3. I reassumed my function as Vice-President after the elections at the OVO AGM, held on Saturday, April 24, 2021 by Zoom Videoconference, where Jane Fawcett was elected by acclamation as our new OVO President for a two-year term.
4. This paragraph summarizes the 2021 OVO First Quarter's activities, while I was still the OVO Acting President: (1) A Contactless Registration Process for our OVO PTs has been established and posted on our Website for the beginning of 2021. Unfortunately, due to the lockdown, all scheduled walks for January 2021 were cancelled. (2) I prepared and circulated to the OVO Executive a draft copy of my 2020 Vice/Acting President Annual Report at the beginning of February 2021. (3) A committee composed of myself and Jane Fawcett was established in February 2021 to review and update the OVO Constitution for approval at the OVO AGM in April 2021. (4) The OVO PT Group Walking re-started on February, 20, 2021, with the two local clubs agreeing to alternate walks on both Saturday and Sunday, starting on the weekend of March 6-7, 2021. (5) A Neighbourhood Walks Tracking Sheet was also created to track personal walking for those wishing to submit their kms and pay fees to OVO PTs. (6) A Second Quarter OVO events' schedule was submitted for April, May and June 2021 at the March OVO Executive Meeting relating to the OVO AGM in April, the Canadian Tulip Festival in May and Pleasant Park Walk in June. (7) Finally, in early April 2021, another stay-at-home was initiated, which was supposed to be in effect until May 20, 2021.
5. My involvement since returning to my Vice-President's position could be summarized as follows: (1) I reviewed, as past Acting President/Chair of our AGM, the draft minutes submitted by our Secretary and provided just a few comments. (2) With respect to the 2021 More Days Walk and Cycle, I had a series of exchanges with the Auberge du Vieux Foyer, in Val-David, QC, which resulted in the rescheduling of the said event on August 19-21, 2022. (3) As suggested by the OVO Executive in August 2021, I have prepared a document on the History of our club Arrow Belt for the upcoming IVV Congress of Delegates to be held in Ottawa in July 2022, which has now been cancelled due to COVID-19.
