



OTTAWA, ON - MANOTICK

Ontario Director's Walk – CVF-ON PT# 054 – Distance: 6K, Rating: 2B SUMMER

Start Point: Mac's, [5511 Manotick Main St., Manotick](#), ON K4M 0E2

CVF Special programs: Famous Canadians, Art in Public Places, Boardwalks, Moving Water

1. Exit Mac's and turn **LEFT** through the parking lot to Bridge St. **LEFT** on Bridge St and cross the bridge over the river to the first street.
2. **LEFT** on Bridge St. and cross the bridge.
3. **LEFT** on West River Dr. **LEFT** on the path, marked by a large boulder (just past #5378). Follow the cinder path through George McLean Park to McLean Cres.
4. **LEFT** on McLean Cres. (No sign, #5347 opposite).
5. **STRAIGHT** on Cecil Rowat Lane at the intersection of McLean and Barnsdale. Almost immediately, **RIGHT** to enter and go through the small parking lot.
6. Take the left-most trail, past the outhouses and **straight** through the park, along the boardwalk, toward the river. **RIGHT** on the path/grassy area along the river. Eventually, go through a controlled access gate and follow the path with the houses on the right and the river on the left. Please respect the private property on each side of the path. Exit the path through another controlled access gate and **follow** the gravel path with the river on your left. **RIGHT** on the paved path at the chain-link fence to Long Island Rd.
7. **LEFT** on Long Island Rd to the intersection at the corner of Long Island Rd, Van Vliet Rd and Bridge St.
8. **RIGHT** to **CROSS** Long Island Rd and **LEFT** to **CROSS** Bridge St. **RIGHT** on Bridge St to the next street. **LEFT** on the street (Mimi's Donuts on the corner). **RIGHT** on the next street (just after #1084). **LEFT** on Millview St. **RIGHT** on the brick path just before #5528. **CROSS** the dam, go up the stairs and continue on the brick path.
9. **RIGHT** on Dickinson St to Bridge St. **CROSS** Bridge St at the lights.
10. **LEFT** on Bridge St. Just before the lights at Manotick Main St, **RIGHT** to enter the parking lot for the strip mall and return to the start point.
