35th Anniversary Walk – CVF 15436
10KM Route Difficulty 2B
Petrie Island 795 Trim Rd, Orleans, ON K4A 3P4

1. From the parking lot, cross to the paved path. Continue along the path with the beach to your left. At the end of the path, veer **right** across the sand to continue on another path. This path will end at Tweddle Rd. Go around the metal barrier and almost immediately go **left** around a second barrier to continue on the Sunrise Trail through the woods.
2. At the road, keep **left (watch for oncoming traffic)** to continue across the causeway and uphill to Jeanne d'Arc Blvd. Carefully **cross** and turn **left** to Trim Rd. **Cross** Trim Rd, turn **right** to the lights at Hwy 174. Carefully **cross** Hwy 174 and continue ahead on Trim Rd to the trail on the **left**.
3. Take the trail, which ends at Baie-des-Castors St. Turn **right** and stay on Baie-des-Castors until it merges with Laporte Ave and Cartographe St (at Millstone Park). Turn **right** to walk along Laporte Ave to Minoterie Ridge and turn **right** for one block to Astrolabe Pl.
4. Turn **right** and continue on Astrolabe Pl, as it veers left, then take the path on the **left** at the end of the street. At the “Y” keep **right** then keep **right** again at the next intersection. You will cross over Cardinal Creek (up 52 steps after the bridge) then continue **straight ahead** on the path exiting at Trim Rd. Turn **right** and walk along Trim Rd to the lights at Hwy 174.
5. Carefully **cross** Hwy 174 then continue straight ahead on Trim Rd. At the stop sign, turn **left** on Jeanne d'A15436rc (no sign). At Tweddle Rd, turn **right** and continue downhill and over the causeway to Basswood Trail, first trail on the **left** after crossing the water. Follow Basswood Trail as it loops around keeping **left** as you exit the woods.
6. Turn **left** on Turtle Trail, which joins up with the Holland Trail, then keep **left**. Continue on the Holland Trail, go around a gate, to the Beaver Trail, first trail on the **left** after the sandy area. Follow the Beaver Trail, which loops around back to the Holland Trail. Turn **left** and go to the end, just before the wooden structure.
7. Turn **right** on the trail (River Loop, no sign) to the beach then continue **right** to walk on the sand. At the orange arrow, veer **right** to continue on the grass to the Holland Trail and turn **left**. Just after the “gate” turn **left** on the first Panorama Loop and follow the trail to get a beautiful view of the Ottawa River. Continue on the trail to make a loop exiting on Holland Trail (very close to where you entered)
8. Just before the brown metal dumpster, keep **left** to continue on a dirt trail. You will pass Friends of Petrie, then keep straight ahead to continue over a small footbridge and back to the beach area. Turn **right** back to the parking lot.
