# CHRISTMAS LIGHTS WALK DOWNTOWN OTTAWA

After a year's absence to walk in Orleans, the OVO Christmas Lights Walk was once again in downtown Ottawa with the start point being City Hall. Registration began at 4:30 with groups departing the area starting at 5PM. Thanks to some great work by our Publicity Coordinator, Marg Dempsey, the turnout this year was the best the club has seen in years with over 130 people (and some 4-legged furry friends) of all ages and sizes coming out on a beautiful snowy evening to enjoy the lights of the city.

Both routes, the 6km and 10km, started out together from City Hall up as far as Wellington St where the with the 6km veered off to the Left and Parliament Hill and the 10km heading in the opposite direction. The lights were on at Parliament however it was still a bit too early to enjoy the show so many people either returned after the walk to see the show or hung around and waited the few minutes for the show to begin.

After leaving Parliament Hill the route continued down Wellington St and past the Garden of the Provinces before turning to cross the river and into Quebec. The route continued down Laurier St, past the Museum of History before turning to cross the Alexandria Bridge and back into Ottawa.

The last part of the 6km route allowed the walkers to enjoy the lights on the Chateau Laurier Hotel, around the War Memorial and the National Arts Centre before heading down Elgin St to the finish at the Fox and Feather Pub. Although the routes went in different directions, both the 6km and 10km were able to enjoy the lights in various locations including Confederation Park, Parliament Hill, the War Memorial and Majors Hill Park.

After all that fresh air and exercise many of the walkers, including many of the first time walkers, stayed at the Pub for a well-deserved bite and a chance to enjoy some time with friends before heading off for Christmas. For all those who joined us for the walk, hope you enjoyed the route and the lights.

Thanks to all the volunteers who helped out at this event; registration table, as a group leader (or sweeper), stamping books, etc. Without you the evening wouldn't have been as great a success as it was.

- 2. Mac's Convenience/Gas Bar CVF-152:-** 1600 Forest Valley Drive, Orléans, Open Monday to Friday 07:00-23:00 and Saturday/Sunday from 08:00-23:00 hrs. Walk Box located at the end of the counter closest to the door to the gas bar, ask staff for the walk box. Free parking is available at the store. Washrooms are not available. **DIRECTIONS:** from Hwy 174 exit Jeanne d'Arc Blvd, turn south on Jeanne d'Arc Blvd pass straight through the traffic circle continuing on Jeanne d'Arc Blvd up the hill, at the 2nd traffic light (Orléans Blvd) turn right, continue to Forest Valley Dr. Mac's Milk convenience is on your right at the gas bar. For more info on this walk call Darlene Blight (613) 830-4782
- 3. Ultramar Service Station CVF-213:-** Corner of Orléans Blvd. and Jeanne d'Arc Blvd. (north intersection). Ultramar is open every day. Registration is from 08:00-19:00 hrs. Free parking and washrooms available. **DIRECTIONS:** Exit Hwy 174 at Tenth Line, head south on Old Tenth Line to Tenth Line and turn left (South) to the Ray Friel Centre on your left just past the Ottawa Public Library, lots of parking. - 5. Beacon Hill Shopping Centre, The Hill Butcher CVF-195:-** 2339 Ogilvie Road. Open weekdays from 09:30-17:00 hrs. Weekends 10:00-17:00 hrs closed statutory holidays. Walk box is on floor to your immediate left in the corner behind the counter. Let staff know you are getting the walk box. Free parking and washrooms available. **DIRECTIONS:** Exit highway 174 at Montreal Rd and head west to Ogilvie Rd. Turn right on Ogilvie Rd to the Beacon Hill Shopping Centre on your left. For more info on this walk call Carrol Jobst (613) 747-2507
- 6. Blackburn Hamlet, Shoppers Drug Mart CVF-233:-** 2638 Innes Road, Ottawa, ON K1B 4Z5. Open daily 08:00- daily. 19:00 hrs. Please ask staff for the walk box. Free parking available at the mall. **DIRECTIONS:** Exit Hwy 174 at the Montreal Rd exit and go East towards Green's Creek. At the traffic lights turn right on Bearbrook Rd into Blackburn Hamlet to Old Innes Rd. Turn left and then right into the parking lot just past the Tim Hortons.
